Carpooling is highly encouraged, so please let Sihing Paul know if you need a ride or can give one. Take 80W from the East Bay and 280N/101N from the South Bay onto 101N to cross the Golden Gate Bridge. Exit at Alexander Ave (go 0.3 mi). Stay left onto Bunker Rd (go 2.5 miles) which, at the Marin Headlands Visitor Center, becomes Field Rd (go 1 mi). The Point Bonita YMCA is on your right.
